Pilgrimage of Faith Appeal Ending

On behalf of the Bishop can I extend a big expression of thanks to all those who have contributed to this year's Pilgrimage of Faith. As you will know, the funds from this appeal go to help some specific ministries carried out by the diocese in the name of all of us. As part of this appeal each parish is set a goal it is asked to reach so that each parish

shares equally – according to size and income – the cost of these special ministries of the diocese. As yet we here in Fernie are still a little short of our goal. Although we have raised a very commendable \$10,000 for the diocese, our goal requires us to raise another \$1,600. If you haven't made a donation to the Pilgrimage of Faith yet this year can we ask you to consider making a donation in the next couple of weeks before the appeal ends at the end of the month; if you have contributed but perhaps not as much as you intended, again there is still time; or if you have some spare money hanging about this would be a good appeal to give it to. Whatever is left of our goal at the end of September will have to be made up from parish funds, so giving to this appeal means that you are supporting the diocese and at the same time financially helping the parish. Donations can be put in the normal collection in an enveloped marked "Pilgrimage of Faith" and this money will be tax receipted in the normal way.
