

#### 2016/2017 Pilgrimage of Faith Appeal Ending

The date set to end our current Pilgrimage of Faith Appeal campaign will be the morning of Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September. Thank you to those of you who have already made their donation. We have collected \$10,100 which is a great amount. But the diocese sets a goal for each parish dependent upon its size and finances, and so we still require another \$1,500 in order to reach this goal. If you haven't made a donation to the Pilgrimage of Faith this year can we ask you to consider making a donation in the next couple of weeks before the appeal ends; if you have contributed but perhaps not as much as you intended, again there is still time; or if you have some spare money hanging about this would be a good appeal to give it to. Whatever is left of our goal at the end of September will have to be made up from parish funds, so giving to this appeal means that you are supporting the diocese and at the same time financially helping the parish. Donations can be put in the normal collection in an enveloped marked "Pilgrimage of Faith" and this money will be tax receipted in the normal way.

# Needs of the Church in Canada Collection $\frac{-23^{rd} \& 24^{th} September -}{\text{Why is there such a collection?}}$

Next weekend at the Masses there will be a second collection for 'The Needs of the Church in Canada'. Every year the Bishops of Canada make this appeal for financial assistance to support their work and the work of each diocese. The President of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB), Bp. Douglas Crosby OMI., Bishop of Hamilton, has described this collection as an invitation to "all the faithful to participate in the life and mission of the Church through their active involvement in the life of their parish community, their prayers, their diverse charisms, their moral support, and the contributions of their time and talents. The Collection for the Needs of the Church is an opportunity for Catholics to truly help their diocese participate in the regional episcopal assemblies and in the CCCB. This annual charitable initiative furthers the collegiality and synodality of the Bishops' ministry in leading, shepherding, teaching, guiding, sanctifying and pastorally caring for all of God's children, disciples of Christ in Canada." As in the past, any monies contributed to the Collection for the Needs of the Church in Canada over and above our CCCB assessment, will be sent to 'Catholic Mission in Canada' to assist our sisters and brothers in the northern dioceses of Canada. This collection will take place next weekend, 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> September.
