The Syrian Family Refugee Committee have not been able to get answers as to why they have been delayed but hope that they will be arriving soon. We ask that you keep these young people in your prayers until we have them safely in our community.

Floods in India – From Fr. Thomas

Many in the parish will know Fr. Thomas who is a priest of our diocese. His family are affected by the recent floods in India. On the 20th of August Fr. Thomas wrote the following, but obviously

by the time you read this more people might have been affected.

"India is suffering disastrous floods. Kerala, one of the south eastern provinces of India is badly affected by this flooding. Monsoon rains started at the end of May. Later, due to low pressure systems out at sea, the rains continued. Damage: So far 357 people have lost their lives. There are 3,050 rescue camps in Kerala where 400,000 people are waiting for food and basic needs.

Also, 28,000 houses have collapsed, and 27,000 houses have been partially damaged. The province lost 45,000 hectors of cultivation, 46,000 cattle and 200,000 ducks and chickens have died (these are a significant food source for many people in India).

16,000 kilometres of national highways, 82,000 state highways and 134 bridges are damaged. The estimated famage of the roads runs to 30 billion rupees (over \$500 million Canadian dollars) and to bridges 80 billion rupees (nearly \$1.5 billion Canadian dollars).

Two of my cousins are in rescue camps. One of my nephews has a foot of water in his house and another has got two feet of water.

This is the biggest disaster in this region in the last century. Please pray for the suffering people.
