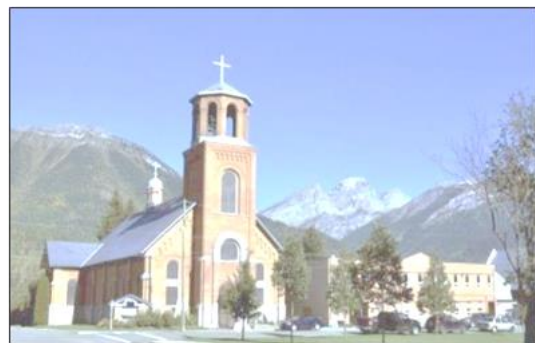

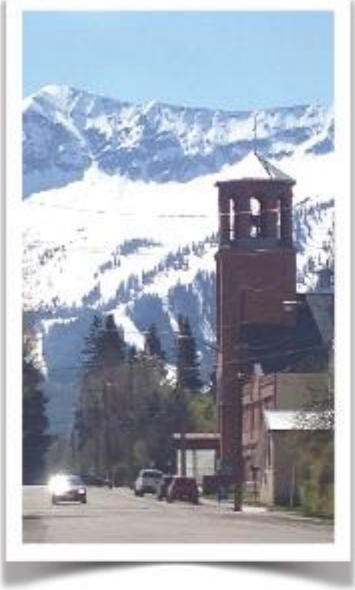
The Salvation Army Christmas Kettle Campaign
