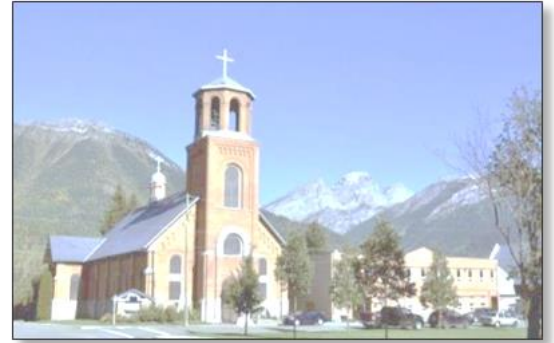

So please remember that in Fernie there is Mass in Rocky Mountain Village most weeks\* on Wednesday at 11am, and in Sparwood at Lilac Terrace on Friday at 11am. We use the Sunday readings and Sunday prayers at these Masses because for many who attend, it is their only Mass of the week. (And, of course, you can also offer your weekly collection envelope at either of these Masses!) So while our Saturday night and Sunday celebrations are the proper weekend Masses, if you are left with no other choice, most weeks you might still be able to attend Mass and hear the Sunday readings.
