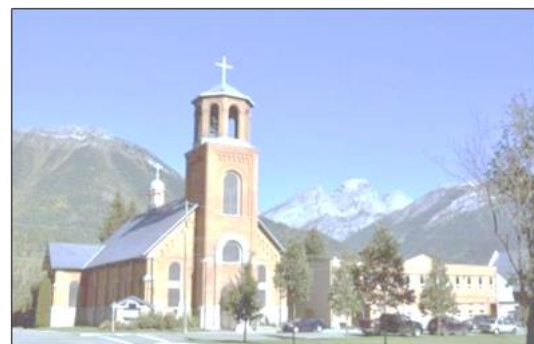

Bishop-Elect Bart van Roijen Appointed as Bishop of Corner Brook and Labrador



On 28th September the Holy Father, Pope Francis appointed Fr. Bart van Roijen as the 11th Bishop of Corner Brook and Labrador! Bishop-elect van Roijen will be ordained to the episcopate on 12th December this year at the Cathedral of the Most Holy Redeemer and Immaculate Conception in Corner Brook, Newfoundland.

Farewell Mass for Bishop-elect Bart van Roijen

For those wishing to travel, a farewell Mass for Bishop-elect Bart will be celebrated by Bishop Gregory Bittman on Sunday, the 10th of November at 7:00 at St. Charles Garnier Parish in Kelowna. There will be refreshments after this Mass at their parish hall. All are welcome.

Pastoral Appointments following Fr. Bart's move to Newfoundland.

We have just heard that Fr. Gabriel Chinnaperiannan will be replacing Fr. Bart in St. Charles Garnier Parish in Kelowna. Fr. Gabriel's place in Grand Forks and its missions will be temporarily filled by Fr. Jim Ratcliffe. Fr. Bart was also the Vicar General of the diocese, head of the diocesan liturgy commission and vocations director; Fr. Sebastian will become the new Vicar General, Fr. Cerlouie Jimenez will lead the liturgy commission and Fr. Rex Velmonte will become our new vocations director. In summary: there is no change of personnel at this end of the diocese!
