


CONFESSIONS



Saint of the Week

St. Domínic Savio was born April 2, 1842, in Riva, Italy to a poor but devout family. Dominic went to Mass often and knelt before the church no matter the weather conditions, praying. He became an altar boy and received a dispensation to receive the Holy Eucharist at age 7, quite unusual at the time. Dominic said the day of his First Holy Communion was the happiest one of his life. That day he wrote down these resolutions: I will go to Confession often, and as frequently to Holy Communion as my confessor allows. I wish to sanctify the Sunday festivals in a special manner. My friends shall be Jesus and Mary. Death rather than sin. Dominic's teacher introduced him to Father (now Saint) John Bosco, and Don Bosco challenged Dominic to study an apologetics booklet and give him a report on it. Dominic did so, and with a speed and accuracy that amazed Don Bosco. Don helped Domonic enter seminary studies at the Oratory, where Dominic excelled, taking on penances willingly, even at the expense of his health. Don Bosco directed him to focus on his studies and not on severe penances, which Domonic followed. Nonetheless Domonic became sick sometime later, an illness which everyone except for him thought he would recover from. Domonic died on March 9, 1857, at the age of 14.



- Round Table


