

Shelia Webster



Saint of the Week



St John Bosco, known affectionately as Don Bosco, was born in Becchi, Italy, on August 16th, 1815. John's father died when he was just two years old, leaving his family in poverty. In spite of these difficulties, John faithfully attended Mass and he and his family helped those in need whenever they could. Jesus and Mary appeared to John in a dream when he was nine, showing him a group of boys and telling him that he would win their hearts over. While still a boy, John saw a traveling circus and learned their tricks and sleights of hand so he could capture the attention of others. John wanted to become a priest, but he lacked the education and financial resources. His brother opposed John's vocation, but John was relentless. He had an incredible memory and could recite homilies from heart that he had heard. At age twenty, John entered seminary and six years later was ordained a priest in 1841. He was assigned to the city of Turin, an industrial city with many poor people including street children. Fr. Bosco, as he was now known, used circus tricks to engage the boys, then he would share the Gospel with them. He worked with his own mother, Mamma Margherita, to find work and homes for the boys and established the Society of St. Francis de Sales in 1859. He died on January 31st, 1888.




Office Space Available for Rent


