

# Saínt of the Week

*St. Anthony of Padua* was a Franciscan Friar and priest who lived in the early 1200s. Originally from Lisbon, Portugal, he was a contemporary of St. Francis, who entrusted young Franciscans with priestly vocations to St. Anthony's tutelage. St. Anthony became

famed as a preacher and teacher, though this was not due to any training or desire on his part. Rather, his great holiness enabled him to speak as the Holy Spirit led him, to the edification and amazement of all who heard him. St. Anthony is



dearly loved by countless Catholics, and his intercession is powerful. I and others can attest to being able to find lost articles through his intercession. He is traditionally depicted as holding the baby Jesus, following the story that the Count of a castle near Padua one time saw St. Anthony holding and speaking with Jesus.
