Pastor's Message

Dear Friends,

As I had gone through your present financial situation, I was surprised to see that two parishes and one mission parish are not doing good to maintain themselves in recent years. Since we need to handle these, I thought to inform and **guide you all during Holy Mass last weekend.** I know that we cannot do any miracle all on a sudden. But we can work together hard enough **to get out of these sad situations.**

First of all, let us concentrate our attention on the **Pilgrimage of Faith appeal** goal. Many of the bigger and some of the smaller parishes fulfil their target of Diocesan goal and have another parish goal above the diocesan goal to achieve some of their urgent needs. Hence they achieve both these goals and get back a big sum, saving diocesan tax (Cathedraticum). That is a double benefit for all those parishes.

Remember, every dollar we collect above the diocesan target is returned to the parish tax-free. Every normal income we have in the parish needs to pay 17.5% Cathedraticum.

My request at this juncture for you: try your best to contribute to the pilgrimage of Faith goal in the present month September 2023. If you do not have additional money, specify your Sunday donation as Pilgrimage of Faith and we will be able to save some of our parish income.

Once we have completed one task, we will think of ways and means to keep our parishes in green for us as well as for our children and grandchildren. God will help us if we ask, pray and work together to achieve any goal.

A special note for the Holy Family Parish members of Fernie:

The day you stop week day mass in any parish is the first death bell for that parish. If you realize that try to have at least two holy Masses on Weekdays. To begin with he week day Mass, please come and attend regular weekday Mass at "Rocky Mountain Village, Fernie at 11 am on all Wednesdays, please. Whenever the number increases the number five, we will have another weekday Mass on Thursdays too. Thus you will be blessed with two week day Masses and Weekend Mass.

Let me thank all who attended the **first parish council Meeting** on September 6, 2023. Many things were discussed about bringing up the parish to the past glorious days. Let us all cooperate with each other and **work hard to bring back our parish to the past glorious days for our children and grandchildren.**
