Pastor's Message

Dear Friends.

- 1. I am thankful to Jim Britoya for his offer of a room heater for use in the Rectory.
- 2. We have started Catechism classes at Sparwood on Monday at 3.15 pm under the leadership of Linda Deluca, Trudy Colonello and Lillian to care for the future members of the Church.
- 3. Mass time for St. Bernard's Church Elkford on Sundays from October 8 will be at 1 pm instead of 4 pm. Let me thank each member of the parish for their unanimous opinion to have their Mass at an early time.
- 4. I am thankful to all of you who are responding positively to my request of special donation towards the Pilgrimage Faith Appeal. Remember, every dollar we collect above the diocesan goal is returned to the parish. We can use them for any urgent need of the parish. Every other normal income we have in the parish is taxed 17.5% Cathedraticum.
- 5. Once we have completed one task, we will think of ways and means to keep our parishes in green for us as well as for our children and grandchildren. God will help us if we ask, pray and work together to achieve any goal.
- 6. The diocese has already reimbursed the parish, the Cathedraticum they have wrongly taken from the Grant money of the Holy Family Parish, on March 23, 2023.

Secondly, the Diocese will reimburse the parish, taxes paid on the three plots of land behind the church as they belong to the diocese.

- 7. **Parish Pastoral Council** is established to foster pastoral activity in the parish. The minimum number should be at least 3 to any odd number.
- 8. Monday September 25 Holy Mass at 8.30 am. No Mass on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Friday at 11 am Mass at Lilac Terrace.

A special note for the Holy Family Parish members of Fernie:

The day you stop weekday mass in any parish is the first death bell for that parish. If you realize that, try to have at least two holy Masses on Weekdays. To begin with the weekday Mass, please come and attend regular weekday Mass at "Rocky Mountain Village, Fernie at 11 am on all Wednesdays. Whenever the number of attendees increases more than five, we will have another weekday Mass on Thursdays. Thus, you will be blessed with two weekday Masses and one Weekend Mass. Let us all cooperate with each other and work hard to bring back our parish to the past glorious days for our children and grandchildren.
