Pastor's Message: March 17, 2024

5th Sunday of Lent

Holy Week celebrations begin with "Palm Sunday Celebrations" on March 24, 2024.

Passion Sunday celebration is the memorial of Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem marked a double departure for Jesus and His three-year public ministry. The arrival at Jerusalem was both a precursor to his pending crucifixion and from a deviation from the ministry in which Jesus travelled on foot attracting many of the ordinary people who were looking eagerly for the Messiah.

Jesus' triumphant entry in Jerusalem leads him to celebrate the paschal mysteries, instituting the Holy Eucharist and Priesthood on Holy Thursday with a message to celebrate it whenever we gather together in His name. He completed this sacrifice on Good Friday through his crucifixion on Good Friday and Resurrection from the dead-on Easter Sunday.

On this solemn day of Passion Sunday, we begin the Holy Week. May our voices join with those who cry out, "Hosanna, Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord"
