Passion (Palm) Sunday

Information

What is The Chrism Mass?

1. It is the annual Mass celebrated by the Bishop with all the priests of the diocese prefer-ably on Monday after Palm Sunday or any day before Good Friday. During this Mass, bishop blesses the Oil of the Sick used for the last sacrament or anointing of the sick, blessing of the Oil of Catechumens and the consecration of the Chrism used for baptism as well as for ordinations. This Holy Mass is the manifestation of the Priest's communion with their Bishop. During the Holy Mass all receive Eucharist in both specious to signify the unity of the Presbyterate of the Diocese. Usually, the blessing of the oil takes place after the Liturgy of the Word.

On this day all priests renew publically their priestly promises.

- 2. Holy Week or the Passion Week celebrations begin with "Palm Sunday Celebrations" is on March 24, 2024. It is the remembrance of the triumphant entry of Jesus in Jerusalem. This leads him to celebrate the paschal mysteries with his beloved disciples, the instituting the Holy Eucharist and Priesthood with a message to celebrate it whenever we gather in His name. He completed this sacrifice through his crucifixion on Good Friday and Resurrection from the dead-on Easter Sunday. Jesus' Resurrection from the dead is the explicit mark of the guarantee of our resurrection. On this Passion Sunday, we begin the Holy Week. May our voices join with those who cry out, "Hosanna, Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord"
