

Pastor's Message - September 8, 2024

Proposed Weekend Mass time in Elk Valley Parishes from October 19, 2024

Dear Friends,

I am happy and excited to see the increasing number of parishioners and visitors attending Weekend Masses with the additional Masses. Fernie has 62 additional number of participants and Sparwood has 35 additional number of participants on weekends. Since most people like to have the Sunday obligation on Sundays, I think that I should be ready to have it in the prime time of Sunday in all the three churches of my care, from 8. 30 am to 1.30 pm.

There may be some difficulties for some of you, but there is double work and risk for me. As a missionary, I would like to see that the Elk valley parishes be revived fully as to support the parishes to have a full-time pastor. Unlike other single churches supporting a pastor all by itself, Elk valley parishes are fully dependent on each other. Considering all the year-round mass schedule and time with the difficult driving conditions during winter, as well as parishioners to have enough time to spend with the pastor for any potluck snacks or meals, we all need to make some sacrifices. If you are ready for these sacrifices and adjustments, I a happy to render all the possible services and additional Weekend Masses for you.

This new mass schedule will help the members of the parish and visitors to attend Mass in any church of their choice & time in rare cases. Again, this new schedule will help every seniors to drive in daylight and enjoy every meal in their time schedule. Once in a while, we can expect either baptisms or confirmations in any of the parishes which would add at least 15 minutes more to the existing Masses time. The proposed mass time will help me to reach in each parish in time with sufficient rest. I am trying to serve you better in all the Elk Valley parishes, in

your spiritual matters. In case you are late or if it is hard for you to attend your regular Mass, you have a choice to have another Mass at a different time in another church.

If you find that the proposed time is too early or too late for you, or you have too many masses, then I am ready to go back to the earlier Mass schedule without any additional week-end masses. I hope and wish to have your feed back and suggestions in writing, within two weeks. I will take them into consideration before I finalize the proposed weekend Masses. Once we decide everything, there will not by any change for five or more years.

So far, I have received just one suggestion. If there are any other suggestions or comments, we will decide the proposed new time and mass schedule from October 19 onwards.
