

" Unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit." (John 12:24) This verse reminds us that true fruitfulness comes only through letting go and surrendering ourselves to God's will. A grain of wheat seems insignificant until it is buried in the earth—only then does it break open and bring forth new life. In the same way, our lives attain meaning when we are willing to die to selfishness, pride, and comfort, and allow God to transform us. Family life is a life of contentment and happiness as we share ourselves with our dear and near ones, sharing our joys and sorrows together. It is a kind of service, but at its heart it is dying to self in a hidden love.

Each day brings chances to surrender: giving up rest for the sick of a family member, remaining patient under criticism, or keeping silence when wrongly accused. These quiet deaths are precious in God's eyes. Jesus Himself emptied His glory, taking the form of a servant for our sake. Our sacrifices, though small, are seeds planted in God's soil, destined to bear fruit in ways unseen. In heaven we will see how nothing was wasted. "Conquer yourself each day from the very first moment, getting up, without yielding to laziness." (St Josemaría Escrivá) The seed that falls into the ground in love will one day blossom in eternal harvest.


