Pastor Message.

"Finally, beloved, whatever is true, whatever is honourable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is pleasing whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things" (Phil 4:8).

This verse gives us a brief summary of Christian ethics, where St Paul stresses on moral excellence and asks believers to dwell on godly virtues. Human mind is set on one thing or other. Paul asks us to set our minds on right things as that which is true, Noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent and praise worthy.

'True' aligns our thoughts with reality and truth, 'Honourable' refers to thinking in a right way that is honourable and dignified. 'Just' refers to moral correctness and justice.

'Pure' pertains to maintaining purity of thought and being free from moral blemish or corruption. 'Lovely' refers to that which inspires joy and admiration abolishing quarrels and strife. 'Honourable' indicates to that which is commendable and worthy of regard avoiding all that are petty and cheap.

'Excellent' refers to pursuing exceptional qualities that reflect God's own character and 'praiseworthy' concerns with dwelling on things that are worthy of praise and honour.

St Paul asks us to set our minds on such things and in the coming days, we are going to dwell on some of the human qualities which we as members of the Catholic Church, need to have in our personal life, so that we can excel in our family life and find fulfillment in our lives.

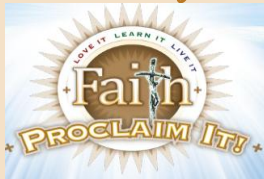
