Vulnerability.

"Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest" (Mt 11:28)

This is an invitation to those who are trying to be good, finding their tasks difficult, and are driven to weariness and despair. Jesus invites them to approach Him and find consolation and comfort. We, priests and laity, are at times taxed by duties, choked by tedium, shadowed by loneliness, unsettled or troubled by our own imperfections, and even misunderstood and persecuted by others; Jesus invites us to find solace and comfort in Him.

Vulnerability is the willingness to be open, honest and susceptible for emotional exposure. It involves embracing uncertainty, imperfections and risks. Vulnerability requires courage, self-acceptance and firm faith in God, who invites us for rest. In priestly ministry, vulnerability fosters humility and authenticity, making space for deep communion with God and compassionate solidarity with others. While faced with difficulties, the divine inspiration encouraged St Paul with the words "My grace is sufficient for you" (2 Cor.12:9).

The members of our parishes shall carry out the mandate of service by transforming themselves, imitating the compassionate love of Jesus for the suffering humanity and with a self-sacrificing and selfless dedication and commitment.

Information:

Ash Wednesday is on February 18. It is mandatory for all the faithfuls to observe lenten fast on Ash Wednesday as well as Good Friday. Either you can have no food for 24 hours, or one food within 24 hours or two or three very small meals in 24 hours. It's your health and commitment to your Faith in the Lord. You can repeat it on all Fridays of Lent, if you like. You can have abstinence of meat or wine or another food for lent.

1. On Ash Wednesday the Holy Mass at Rocky Mountain Village, Fernie at 11 am, will have ashes for the participants. There will be a special Mass at Holy Family Church Fernie at 12 noon with the ashes for the participants.



2. Reconciliation services for Lent: March 4 Wednesday at 12 noon at Holy Family Church, Fernie.

3. There is one Candidate for RCIA, this year. (1) Marilyn Bruschetta, from Holy Family Church, Fernie

4. I was trying to have a proper Parish Council in Fernie having at least 15 members, representing the whole parish of 150 people. So far, I have received just 5 applications. 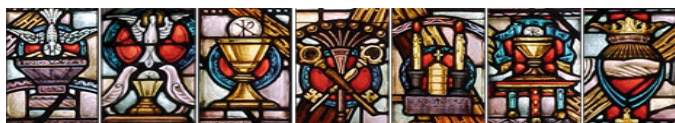
