## <u>81<sup>st</sup> Annual CWL</u> <u>Nelson Diocesan</u> <u>Convention</u> –

Thursday to Saturday this week.

*The CWL write*... The last time our parish here in Fernie was involved in hosting a CWL Diocesan Convention was over thirty years ago in 1986, so the ladies of our League are very

excited about this event. Ninety-two women from across the diocese will be participating. This year the theme for the Convention is "Inspired by the Spirit; Women Respond to God's Call".

Our guests will start arriving on Thursday when we will be meeting and greeting people who might have travelled quite long distances.

On Friday morning, after starting with Morning Prayer, the convention will hear from Corrie Hurlburt from the Elkford Women's Taskforce who will talk about families in Crises. In the afternoon 'Wills and Powers of Attorney' and the Women's Resource Centre are additional topics that will be presented. Late afternoon we will all travel to Sparwood where we will celebrate Mass at St. Michael's; this will be followed by a dinner and entertainment in Sparwood. (*Please note that there will be a collection at the Friday Mass for families experiencing crises.*)

On Saturday again the day will start with Morning Prayer and then there will be some business meetings for our CWL ladies including feedback and news from other CWL conventions across Canada.

The big event of the convention will be on Saturday when our bishop, Bp. John Corriveau OFM Cap., will lead our closing Mass and then be the guest of honour at our convention banquet. At the same time the Bishop will be installing and blessing the CWL Diocesan Executive for the next year.

At this banquet Major David Dean from the local Salvation Army church will be the guest speaker and he will respond to the convention's theme of "Inspired by the Spirit; Women Respond to God's Call".
