Fr. David writes...

Standing For the Bring Forward of the Gifts – Back in October I mentioned that the General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM) does not ask us to stand for the bringing forward of the gifts. This practise then all but stopped, but then over Christmas one lady stood at this point and then everyone else in the church stood! So obviously it is worth repeating what was written last October.

GIRM is the document approved by the Bishops of Canada that gives us principles about what we ought to do when celebrating Mass. With reference to the bringing forward of the gifts the GIRM specifically says that we should be seated,

"The faithful should sit... during the readings before the Gospel and the Responsorial Psalm and for the Homily and *during the Preparation of the Gifts at the Offertory...*" (GIRM §43)

Therefore it is desirable that we don't stand for the offertory procession, that is, the bringing forward of the collection and the gifts of bread and wine; rather we should remain seated.

And as I said last October, if you do forget and stand I don't think it really matters tremendously, but hopefully over time this will happen less and less so we are in line with the rest of the diocese and with the instructions we have from the Canadian bishops.
