# Saint of the Week



St Peregrine was born in northern Italy around 1260. He grew up in a family in an area that was under interdict from the pope, and when St. Philip Benizi came to reconcile the people back to the Pop, Peregrine attacked him violently. Some time later, Peregrine repented, found St. Philip and asked his forgiveness, joined the Servite order in Siena, and was ordained a priest. He was renowned for his preaching and holiness. Later in his life he developed a cancerous disease in his leg; the doctors planned to amputate it, but after Peregrine prayed fervently the doctors found his leg to be miraculously healed. As such, Peregrine is the patron of those suffering from cancer and is often turned to from other illnesses.
