


CONFESSIONS








Saint of the Week

~ Our Lady of Fatima ~

The Blessed Virgin Mary appeared in 1917 to three Portuguese children: Lucia, Francisco, and Jacinta. From May 13th to October 13th, she appeared six times in the little village of Fatima, Portugal. World War I or The Great War as it was known at the time, was ongoing, leaving devastation across Europe. Our Lady of Fatima came at this pivotal time telling the children that peace was possible if the people would heed her warnings. Lucia, Francisco, and Jacinta were

reared in faithful Catholic homes, in a town that remained faithful to the Church amidst persecution from the government. Lucia de Jesus Santos and her cousins, Francisco and Jacinta Marto, were devout children. Through the apparitions of



our Lady, the children grew in holiness and wisdom that belied their young age. Francisco and Jacinta both died a few years later, as our Lady had informed them, while Lucia lived to be 97 years old. Pope Francis canonized Jacinta and Francisco on May 13, 2017, in Fatima on the 100th anniversary of the apparitions. The Miracle of the Sun occurred on October 13, 1917, witnessed by 70, 000 people. Our Lady of Fatima had told the children of the date and place if would occur. All could look directly at the sun without injury to their eyes. The sun grew in size, shrunk, rotated and spun, looking as if it were dancing. Even non-Catholics and unbelievers witnessed their miracles, and many were converted to God and asked forgiveness for their sins. The Church through the local Bishop declared the apparitions to be worthy of belief in October 1930.
