March 20, 2020, was an uncertain and disrupted time for Holy Family Parish. The pandemic brought an unknown future. Provincial rules closed our church doors, and we lost our fellowship and place of worship. Thanks to the ingenuity of Father David, virtual Masses were broadcast with one camera from a storage room in the Fernie Family Center. Our celebrations continued to grow, eventually back into the church with parishioners seated and with many on-line participants. In March 2022 attendance is strong, in person and virtually. Our 5 o'clock Saturday Mass has a choir, a pianist and people attending virtually, from several Canadian provinces, communities in British Columbia, American states and occasionally, even from Mexico

The resilience of our Fernie faith community was truly remarkable. Father adjusted his Masses, offered communion to individuals in the cars after mass, even on Christmas Eve and on summer evenings. Volunteers in April 2020 rang the church bell at 7:00 pm in support of Fernie's essential workers. Volunteers continued with the restoration of heritage building church, raising funds, restoring the windows, repairing the bell tower roof. Our fincial health was uncertain in the beginning but continued to strengthen as our loyal parishioners supported the church throughout the pandemic. Thank you everyone.
