#### From Fr. David...

#### Sermon on the Mount

Lent will start on Wednesday  $1^{st}$  March; between now and then there are five Sundays. The gospel readings for these five weeks all come from Jesus' "Sermon on the Mount" (Matthew 5:1 - 7:29).

Matthew's gospel shares of a lot of common material with Mark's gospel, but one feature of Matthew's gospel that is different from Mark's gospel is the inclusion of five long speeches by Jesus; these are called 'teaching sections' when Jesus teaches either the crowds or his disciples. The 'Sermon on the Mount' is the first of these five, it is also the longest and some consider it to be the most important.

This weekend we will hear the beginning of this first speech with the section called 'The Beatitudes' because Jesus makes nine statements all starting with "Blessed are...". Next weekend we will hear how we are 'salt and light'. On 12<sup>th</sup> February we have a long gospel which goes through anger, adultery, divorce and oaths (*and we are hoping Fr. Jim Ratcliffe will be here to preach on this gospel*). On the 19<sup>th</sup> February we hear the end of chapter five of Matthew's gospel which closes with the words, "Be perfect, therefore, as your Heavenly Father is perfect." For the final weekend before Lent we will hear the end of chapter six which



similarly ends with a beautiful verse, "So do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring worries of its own. Today's trouble is enough for today."

So as you are listening to the gospel readings over the next five weeks you can bear in mind that Jesus is describing what brings us blessings, he invites us to be part of this, to follow this way and, while acknowledging that there might be challenges on the road, Jesus tells us not to be anxious because "your Heavenly Father knows that you need all these things." (6:32)
