From the Parish...

Fr. David writes... In case you don't hear my homily this week, very briefly what I think I will be saying is that both listening and doing are part of the Christian calling, but our doing should be preceded and fashioned by our listening to God. The story of Martha and Mary does not mean that doing is unimportant, rather it stresses that the only way we guarantee that our efforts are truly part of the building up of the Kingdom of God is if we listen carefully to God. All through the Gospels we get people who think they are doing the will of God and furthering God's Kingdom – *sometimes in heroic ways* – but when it does not proceed from God's Word it can be the opposite of God's will and can hinder the establishment of God's Kingdom. An obvious example of this is Peter who thinks that fighting is the way to establish Jesus as King when in fact it will be his submission that will lead to the establishment of the Kingdom.

So we have to be both listeners and doers.

In relation to both listening and doing, last week in the newsletter there was an appeal for people to read at Mass. I am so delighted that we have some new people who have volunteered to read, that is so good and we thank them.

But we also need more Eucharistic ministers, it would be wonderful if we could find some people who could play a musical instrument so we don't have to rely upon pre-recorded music at Mass, we particularly need people to help set up and clear away after Mass both at our weekend Masses and at our weekday Masses.






Our Pilgrimage of Faith
