

Homecoming Weekend -20^{th} November, Feast of Christ the King The Pope's 'Year of Mercy' is a time to reach out and proclaim God's love. One practical way we will be doing this is by inviting Catholics who currently aren't involved in the parish to come back to Church.

Next weekend, 19th/20th November, we are having a 'Homecoming' weekend when you are asked to invite Catholics you know to Mass. These might be members of your family, neighbours, friends, colleagues, or anyone. That is part one.

Part two is that next weekend all of us who do regularly come to Mass must be super welcoming to anyone who turns up. That means that next weekend we must remember that we are not coming to church to fulfil some private need, rather we will be coming to church to give of ourselves to others. As we are walking up to the church we should be looking to see who else is parking. As we come into church, is there someone we should say hello to and then even sit by? Once seated, is there someone coming in who we should be acknowledging and invite to sit next to us? During Mass we must be praying very particularly for those who are with us once again. And then after Mass we must allow extra time to stop and chat, have coffee and generally be interested in those who turn up.

Of course, unless we invite and positively encourage people to come next week, then there won't be anyone to welcome! So please do take an invitation and talk to people about what attending Mass means to you. Offer to meet them in the parking lot and walk in with them.

New Carpets – Anne Majic writes

The Church Restoration Committee is happy to report that the installation of the new carpet is scheduled to begin later this month. As previously mentioned, this project is being done as much for safety as aesthetics; the new carpet will minimise 'trip hazard' for people using our church. It is a very high quality product so should last a long time. The project also involves restoration work to the kneelers, which many will appreciate.

The colours of the carpet have been chosen by a professional designer who is an expert in church renovation, so we hope the new carpets will further enhance the wonderful work that was done some years ago when the building was restored and redecorated.

We are incredibly fortunate to have parishioners who have worked very hard to find and apply for grants to help us with this project. As a result of this when we ask the parish for donations to cover the cost of this important improvement we only need to ask them for a relatively small proportion of the whole cost. Those who work with our finances are always trying to get the best deal they can for the parish, particularly looking at what other financial support is available. Most funding will require us to provide a certain percentage of the final costs, but please know that because of this each dollar you give will have a big effect. **We still need to raise approximately \$2,500** towards the total cost of \$32,000 and have donations of \$850 to date.
