Update from the Restoration Committee:

The Holy Family Church Restoration Committee in conjunction with Fr. David and Parish Council is pleased to announce the beginning of Phase 4 of the church restoration- the installation of new carpet in the church and the repair and reupholstering of the kneelers. The estimated cost is \$32,000. The committee has procured government grant money and individual donations towards this undertaking however we are in need of an additional \$7,000 from our parishioners to complete the project. As many of you know, our church restoration has been ongoing since 2003 when a fund was established in honour of George Majic, a long-time parishioner. With generous donations in his name from parishioners and friends and with government grant money, two major phases were completed- Phase 1, the cleaning of the church interior from ceiling to basement, the painting of the interior, the cleaning and restoration of the mural over the altar, the refurbishing of the gold leaf on the altars, the installation of new lights; Phase 2, the replacing of all the insulation in the upper walls and ceiling, the installation of a new roof, the painting of all exterior trim and the copula, the repair of the lighting in the bell tower, the installation of a new sound system in the church. Then Phase 3 was undertaken and accomplished through the generosity of Mr. Alan Cairns the uncle of Gloria Blakey, and it entailed the building and erection of the beautiful new sign outside the church. Any gift we can give towards Phase 4 to be completed by Christmas will be greatly appreciated. Envelopes are provided in the entrance to the church.

Syrian Refuge Family for Fernie Committee Update

Thanks to a wonderful team effort by our group of volunteers, the fundraising projects at the 2016 Chautauqua Fernie Fall Fair were a tremendous success. Fellowship, fine weather, and presentations by local authors and musicians also combined to make the Friday evening pie and ice cream social and the Saturday morning family breakfast very enjoyable occasions for all.

Altogether more than \$2,500 was raised towards sponsorship of a Syrian Refuge Family, and more than 400 happy customers enjoyed a delicious meal or desert! This amount brings the total funds raised to date to more than \$10,000

The Committee expresses our sincere appreciation to Smitty's Restaurant, Independent Grocers, McDonald's restaurant, and Save-On-Foods for corporate donations of food and coffee for the breakfast, and to the Fernie Fire Department for lending us their propane cooking grills.

The Committee is also searching for additional volunteers and for further fund-raising ideas and opportunities. We are open to all suggestions from Parishioners.
