Sunday 25th September 2016 **Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Fr David writes...

I write this just before I head out to the airport to fly back to Canada from Iceland. I will have had only three full days in Iceland, but I have enjoyed them. I should say that the weather has been awful; it has rained on an off the whole time, the skies have been grey, it has been cold and yesterday we had a force ten gale which produced winds so strong that at times it was difficult to walk, and even when driving one battled to keep the car on the road. Yet that is part of what Iceland is - a rocky outcrop at the northern end of the Atlantic Ocean. It is a very barren country. Some areas of the lowlands are fertile and green from all the rain, but most parts are rugged, windswept hills, and as much of the rock is volcanic and very black these hills and mountains look even more bleak. Like parts of the west coast of Ireland or the northern parts of Scotland, houses are tucked away in little hollows or snuggled next to hills in an attempt to avoid the worst of the storms. Then close by there will be a waterfall that will take ones breath away - the force of the water which falls in powerful arrows that never end and the noise and the spray, and then a few metres further down stream the water is a calm river as if nothing had happened. On a bit further and there is steam rising from the ground; it might be a farmer extracting the geothermal heat for his greenhouse, or it might just be a spring gushing hot water into a stream. Last night I sat all alone in a deep crater of a volcano as the wind whistled around me; as the sky turned from grey to dark blue I just marvelled at this place. Iceland does not have classical beauty but it is spectacular and I would love to come here again and have a bit more time just to be still in this rugged land.
